Nick went on to explain that some received as much as a 5% raise while others a lesser percentage. Mayor Kalvaitis stated that those getting higher percentage raises made less money. Council President Kappatos stated that he thought we were opening ourselves up for litigation. Again, a discussion ensued regarding the effective date of resolution. Administrator Richard Wright stated that management raises are usually not done until later in the year because of unsettled contracts. Rich stated that he thought the effective date should be January 1 since that is when all of the other raises became effective. Councilwoman Passio asked if we had to give a raise even though evaluations were never done. Solicitor Wood explained that evaluations were council's prerogative but the statute does not require evaluations in order to give this raise. Council President Kappatos further explained that evaluations were not a

component of any other contract, which included raises, that council already had voted on. Councilman Root asked what the options were.

Council President Kappatos stated that he would not make another motion regarding this issue but asked if anyone else wished to make a motion for this resolution. Councilwoman Kelly stated that she thought that we would be opening ourselves up to litigation if we did not pass this. Eleanor also stated that she has been in office for six months and felt a lot had been accomplished during that period. Councilwoman Kelly stated that she wanted to move on and settle this issue. Councilwoman Moore stated that she had already approached the non-contractuals in her department and that the acting superintendent had not yet responded to her inquiry as to why raises should be given. Councilwoman Kelly also stated that she had talked to the non-contractuals in her department.

Councilwoman Passio wanted to know if any new information would indicate we have to say yes, if our hands are tied, since she read the statute and she did not think we had to give the raise. Council President Kappatos asked Solicitor Wood how to reintroduce the resolution to increase the salaries of the Clerk, Collector, CFO and Assessor per 40A:9-165. Solicitor Wood stated that this could be done by introducing a new resolution. Councilman White wanted to know why we had to adopt the resolution tonight. Council President Kappatos explained that the personnel committee had met with the solicitor, this resolution had already been tabled at the last meeting and we only meet once a month. Mayor Kalvaitis stated that no one had talked to her about this resolution.
