# RESOLUTION URGING TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND REAUTHORIZATION AND INCREASED FUNDING FOR LOCAL TRANSPORATION

WHEREAS, local officials know that investments in our rapidly deteriorating transportation infrastructure must be made, since failure to do so can compromise the safety of the public, the economic vitality of our communities and the security of our neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (DOT) reports that New Jersey's municipalities are responsible for 64 percent (28,539 center line road miles) of our roads, county governments are responsible for another 22 percent (6,649 center line road miles), and together, local governments are responsible for 39 percent of our bridges; and

WHEREAS, local roadways and bridges carry about 55 percent of all of New Jersey's traffic; and

WHEREAS, just last year, the American Society of Civil Engineers reported that 651 of the 6,554 bridges in New Jersey (9.9%) are considered structurally deficient and 1,717 (26.2%) are considered functionally obsolete, and that driving on roads in need of repair costs New Jersey motorists \$3.476 billion a year in extra vehicle repairs and operating costs – \$601 per motorist, and that 66% of New Jersey's roads are in poor or mediocre condition; and

WHEREAS, in the first year of the Transportation Trust Fund (FY 1985), Local Aid funding represented almost 22 % of total Transportation Capital funding, but over the years, the Local Aid portion was reduced to 16% in FY 1997, 12% in FY 2004, and 15% in FY 2013, so that the average Local Aid funding over the first 29 years of the Transportation Trust Fund was just under 15%, and

WHEREAS, the need for investments in local roads and bridges has not decreased since 1985, and no one has suggested that it will decrease in the future; and

WHEREAS, On May 1, New Jersey DOT then-Commissioner Jim Simpson announced that the State's Transportation Trust Fund is just 14 months away from a \$620 million deficit; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the governing body of the Borough of Runnemede joins with the New Jersey League of Municipalities in supporting the "Forward New Jersey" coalition, and we call on State policy-makers to:

- 1. Reauthorize the Transportation Trust Fund to ensure adequate and reliable funding to meet State and local transportation infrastructure funding needs for the next 10 years;
- 2 Increase Local Aid funding to ensure adequate and reliable funding to meet all local transportation infrastructure needs; and
- 3. Increase the municipal share of Local Aid funding and ensure fair funding for all municipalities; and be it, further,

RESOLVED, that given the extent of the local infrastructure, and given the need for strong and steady investment in that infrastructure, we will call for assurances that Local Aid will represent, at a minimum, 25% of annual Transportation Capital spending, and for adjustments in funding, to account for the effects of inflation; and be it, finally,

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this Resolution be forwarded to Governor Chris Christie, Commissioner of the Department of Transportation Jamie Fox, our State Senator, our two representatives in the General Assembly, and to the New Jersey League of Municipalities.

### **ORDINANCE #15-01**

# AN ORDINANCE TO MANDATING DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES BY THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE PURSUANT TO C. 52:14-15f et. seq.

WHEREAS, P.L. 2013 c. 28, authorizes local governments to mandate direct deposit for certain governmental employees effective after July 1, 2014; and

NEW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough of Runnemede, located in Camden County, State of New Jersey according to the following:

Section 1. All employees and elected public officials who receive compensation from the Borough of Runnemede are mandated to have direct deposit of their compensation as of 1, 2015 in accordance with Chapter 28 P.L. 2013, as defined under C.52:14-15f (b).

Section 2. Seasonal and temporary employees who are employed by the Borough of Runnemede may be exempted from the direct deposit mandate.

Section 3. If any Section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the Section, paragraph subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 5 This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage, adoption and publication according to law.

### **ORDINANCE #15-03**

### **AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 248 - MERCANTILE LICENSE**

WHEREAS, Mayor & Council of the Borough of Runnemede adopted an Ordinance instituting mercantile licensing on 12/30/09; and

WHEREAS, Mayor & Council of the Borough of Runnemede have reviewed the above-referenced ordinance and have decided to amend the ordinance as follows:

### §248-7 Investigations

Upon the receipt of an application for a license, the Borough Clerk shall refer such application to the Zoning Official or other proper officials or officers for the making of the necessary investigations and/or inspections, which shall confirm that a Certificate of Occupancy has been issued, that the use is a permissible use, and to ensure compliance with all laws, codes, ordinances and regulations as sited in §248-9.

### §248-9 Compliance with other provisions

No license shall be issued for the conduct of any business and no permit shall be issued for any thing or act if the premises and building to be used for the proposed business activity do not fully comply with the requirements of the Zoning laws, health codes, Borough Ordinances and Borough regulatory provisions. It shall also be required that all municipal charges including real estate taxes, sewer rental fees and/or property maintenance charges be paid current.

### §248-10 Change of Location; fee

The location of any licensed business or occupation, or of any permitted activity, may be changed upon submission of a Certificate of Occupancy for the new location and the payment of a fee of \$50.00 for the purpose of modifying existing records filed with the Director of Licenses.

### §248-15 Fee Schedule

An initial licensing fee of \$50.00 shall be paid to the Borough Clerk at the time the applicant submits the registration form required by \$284-4. Thereafter, an annual licensing fee of \$50.00 shall be paid on or before January 31st of each year, if any person or entity, who or which is required to obtain a license or permit pursuant to this chapter, does not obtain such a license or permit by January 31st of the respective year, the Borough Clerk will assess a late fee equal to 50% of the licensing fee which is late. All late fees assessed against a business must be paid with the licensing fee. In addition to any late fee, the business must pay all licensing fees for previous years that were not paid and applicable late charges. In any action to enforce this chapter, the Borough Licensing Officer shall include all late fees and past-due licensing fee amounts in the summons and complaints filed against the business or other party. The annual license fees to be paid to the Borough for conducting or engaging in any business, trade, or activity within the Borough of Runnemede, at the place designated in the license certificate, shall be \$50.00.

### §248-16 Fee of unclassified activities

All businesses, trades and activities which have not been classified, or otherwise provided for in any other licensing ordinance of the Borough, shall pay a license fee of \$50.00.

### §248-23 Violations and penalties

Any person who shall violate any provision of this chapter shall be subject to a fine not exceeding \$500.00, or to imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both, for the first offense; \$1,000.00, or to imprisonment not exceeding forty-five (45) days, or both, for the second offense; and, \$2,000.00, or to imprisonment not exceeding sixty (60) days, or both, for the third offense and any subsequent offenses.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, all other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

### **ORDINANCE #15-04**

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LAND USE ORDINANCE IN THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE TO PERMIT AND REGULATE HOME BUSINESSES WITHIN A RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Planning/Zoning Board of the Borough of Runnemede at a regular meeting on October 8, 2014, discussed, considered, reviewed and drafted a proposed supplement to the existing Zoning Ordinance which would define, permit and regulate "home businesses" within a Residential Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, the Planning/Zoning Board of the Borough of Runnemede has determined that it is in the best interest of the residents of the Borough of Runnemede that provisions be made in order to permit and regulate home businesses within a Residential Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, the Planning/Zoning Board of the Borough of Runnemede had recommendation to the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede that an amendment or supplement should be made to the existing Zoning Ordinance so that home businesses are permitted and regulated within a Residential Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, the Planning/Zoning Board of the Borough of Runnemede recommended certain language for which the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede to adopt regarding "home businesses" within a Residential Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, the language recommended by "home businesses" within a Residential Zoning District has been reviewed by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede find that it is in the best interest of the Borough and its taxpayers to amend the code to permit and regulate "home businesses" within a Residential Zoning District; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the governing body of the Borough of Runnemede in the County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 395 – Zoning, of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey is hereby amended to include § 395-25 "Home Businesses" which shall read as follows:

### § 395-25 – Home Businesses

- A. A Home Business shall be a permitted use in all Residential Zoning Districts subject to the following conditions:
  - 1. The gross area devoted to the home business use shall not exceed the lesser of 250 square feet or 10% of the total gross floor living area of the residential property. The area devoted to the business shall be contiguous.

- 2. The home business shall only be operated by the resident owner of the residential dwelling.
- 3. The home business shall be conducted entirely within the primary dwelling or any other accessory building located on the same lot, and only one such use shall be conducted on the premises.
- 4. No more than two (2) clients or patrons may be on the premises for business or professional purposes at any one time.
- 5. There shall be no display or products visible from the street, nor shall any article be sold or offered for sale on or from the premises.
- 6. The residential character of the lot and building shall not be changed or altered.
- 7. No sign identifying or advertising the home occupation shall be permitted.
- 8. No more than one non-resident full-time or part-time employee shall be permitted.
- 9. No sounds emanating from the home occupation use shall be audible outside the residence.
- 10. No equipment shall be used which will cause interference with radio and television reception in neighboring dwellings, nor create other nuisances by its operation.
- 11. Deliveries shall be limited to package services such as United Parcel Service, Federal Express or other recognized delivery service.
- 12. No additional off-street parking shall be generated by such occupation in excess of one (1) automobile.
- 13. No business shall be conducted at the site before 8:00 a.m. or later than 9:00 p.m.
- 14. Only one (1) business vehicle, combined with a trailer, if any, not exceeding 8,000 pounds registered weight, shall be permitted to park at the residential property.
- 15. There shall be no outside storage of any kind related to the home business.
- 16. All home business uses shall specifically maintain solid waste containers which shall comply with the following standards:
  - a. The container shall be watertight and of metal or plastic with a tight-fitting cover and handles. Each container shall have a capacity of not less than 20 gallons nor more than 40 gallons and shall not exceed 50 pounds when containing solid waste material. The volume of solid waste generated from the home business, together with other residential solid waste, shall not exceed 10 receptacles, bags, boxes, bundles, or a combination thereof.
- B. Family day-care homes are permitted as per the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:55d-66.5a, et seq.
- C. Prohibited Home Businesses. The following uses are specifically prohibited as home businesses:
  - 1. Auto repair, refurbishing or servicing.
  - 2. Retail or Wholesale sales of goods, equipment, chattels, fixtures, materials, supplies or any other merchantable items.
  - 3. Restaurant or other food distribution or sales.
  - 4. Tattoo or piercing.
  - 5. Psychic readings.

- 6. Massage parlors.
- 7. Firearm repair.
- 8. Boarding homes.
- 9. Any other forms of business which are specifically prohibited in any commercial district.
- D. All home business uses must be registered with the Clerk of the Borough of Runnemede. An application fee of \$50.00 and permit will be required of the resident prior to commencement of such use. The Construction Code Official or Zoning Officer of the Borough of Runnemede shall inspect the premises to insure compliance with the standards set forth herein for such home business. Any permit granted shall not be transferrable to a subsequent owner of the property. There shall be no other annual fees imposed.
- E. Where all the requirements set forth above are met, no site plan application shall be required.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** all other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon

final passage and publication as required by law.

### **ORDINANCE #15-05**

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE REGARDING VACANT AND ABANDONED PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede ("Borough" and/or "Runnemede") have reviewed recent amendments to Titles 2A, 40 and 46 of the New Jersey Statutes regarding vacant and abandoned property and the responsibilities of foreclosing creditors; and

WHEREAS, as a result of such legislation most recently adopted on August 15, 2014 pursuant to P.L. 2014, c. 35, certain amendments to the Code of the Borough of Runnemede may be implemented; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede that the following provisions of the Code of Borough of Runnemede are amended as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter \_\_\_\_\_ is hereby amended to add of the following new sections:\$\_\_\_\_\_. Creditor responsibility.

Pursuant to the provisions of P. L. 2014, c. 35, a creditor filing a summons and complaint to foreclose a lien on a residential property that is vacant and abandoned, whether the filing of the summons and complaint is made before or after the determination that the property is vacant and abandoned, shall be responsible for the care, maintenance, security and upkeep of the exterior of the residential property. This obligation applies whether the determination that the property is vacant and abandoned is made by the public officer pursuant to the provisions of P.L. 2014, c.35 and/or the Code of the Borough of Runnemede, pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2A:50-73 or otherwise.

### §\_\_\_\_\_. Designated representative of out-of-State creditor; violation.

An out-of-State creditor shall include the full name and contact information of the in-State representative or agent in the notice required to be provided to the municipal clerk pursuant to paragraph one of N.J.S.A. 46:10B-51. An out-of-State creditor found by a court of competent jurisdiction to have violated this provision shall be subject to a fine of \$2,500.00 for each day of the violation commencing on the day after the 10 day period set forth in paragraph one of N.J.S.A. 46:10B-51 with respect to notifying the municipal clerk that an action to foreclose on the property as been filed.

§ Violations and penalties.

Any person, firm, corporation or entity, including a creditor, required to care, maintain, secure and keep up a property under this Chapter cited in a notice issued pursuant hereto for violating any provision of this Chapter, shall upon conviction, be punishable and subject to a fine of \$1,500.00 for each day of the violation.

### §\_\_\_\_ Additional notice required.

Notice of violations of property maintenance, building or other property codes for any property declared vacant and abandoned pursuant to this Chapter shall be given to a foreclosing creditor pursuant to the procedures as required by P.L. 2014, c.35.

SECTION 2: If any part of this regulation is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of the regulation.

SECTION 3: All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect on approval of the provisions of Subtitle One of Title 39, being made applicable to said properties and upon final passage and publication as required by law.

# ORDINANCE AMENDING A CHAPTER OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE, CHAPTER 46 "PERSONNEL POLICIES"

Whereas, Borough Code Chapter 46 is entitled Personnel Policies of the Borough of Runnemede; and

Whereas, the Borough Council has reviewed the Code sections and has determined that certain amendments are necessary

Section 46.5 shall be amended to add:

Payment of the retirement benefit is conditioned upon the Borough of Runnemede receiving written notice of retirement not less than one hundred twenty (120) days prior to the employee's retirement date.

For good and cause and in special circumstances the Borough Council can reduce the notice requirement, on a case by case basis.

Section 46.6 shall be amended to add subsection C:

Healthcare coverage, upon retirement under this section, shall be considered a benefit of the employee. The employee shall retain the health care coverage for the employee's life, when all benefits / coverage hereunder shall terminate. After retirement, the health care benefit shall not be expanded (i.e. single coverage cannot become husband and wife coverage). No persons who were not covered by the employee's health care benefit at the time of retirement, shall be entitled to be covered after retirement.

To receive this health care benefit the employee must notify the Borough of Runnemede, in writing, not less than one hundred twenty (120) days prior to the employee's retirement date.

For good cause and in special circumstances the Borough Council can reduce the notice requirement, on a case by case basis.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of the Borough of Runnemede heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any term or provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.

### **ORDINANCE #15-07**

### **AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 326 - STREETS & SIDEWALKS**

### **ARTICLE III-EXCAVATIONS**

WHEREAS, Mayor & Council of the Borough of Runnemede adopted an Ordinance amending Chapter 326 Streets & Sidewalks Article III-Excavations on 8/6/14; and

WHEREAS, Mayor & Council of the Borough of Runnemede have reviewed the above-referenced ordinance and have decided to amend the ordinance as follows:

§ 326-22 - Permit fees.

In addition to the above deposit, the applicant shall pay a nonreturnable fee to be used to pay the cost of personnel employed to process the application and permit and to inspect the work performed as follows:

Resident - A

A nonreturnable fee in the in the amount of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each and every proposed opening of not more than one hundred (100) square feet in area and an additional sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) is required for each additional area of one hundred (100) square feet or fraction thereof up to three hundred (300) square feet

Business -

A nonreturnable fee in the in the amount of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each and every proposed opening of not more than one hundred (100) square feet in area and an additional sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) is required for each additional area of one hundred (100) square feet or fraction thereof up to three hundred (300) square feet.

Public Utilities-The non returnable fee shall be calculated in accordance with § 326-23. In the case of openings which exceed three hundred (300) square feet, if at any time it becomes evident that the fees are or will be insufficient to cover the costs, the permittee shall pay to the clerk such additional fees certified by the borough engineer as required to meet the costs of the processing and inspection.

If the roadway in which the street opening is being made is less than 5 years old since it was last paved and improved the fee will be \$1,000.00 paid by all applicants for any permit for each opening or excavation to any public street, roadway or highway in the Borough of Runnemede. The repair work for the closing of the street opening shall to allow for proper stabilization and surface to include the use of infrared technology on joints within the excavation.
