These costs shall include, but not limited to, update to the GIS database, revisions to existing Tax Map plates, creation/addition of new Tax Map plates, appropriate revisions to the Key Map(s), reprographic services for applicable Borough, county and state submission copies, as well as any reasonable shipping and handling fees involved.
