Maria Panzarella, 12 S. Oakland Avenue: Ms. Panzarella was upset that NJ American Water had a project on her street and no one had informed her. Ms. Panzarella also stated that more officers were needed in town. Ms. Panzarella also expressed some concerns about borough management.

Joanne Yates, 125 E. 3rd Avenue: Ms. Yates expressed concerns about "strange people" walking down her street. Chief Dailey explained that he could not stop anyone from walking down the street. Ms. Yates also asked if she could hit someone with a baseball bat if they tried to enter her home.

Seeing no one else wishing to speak, a motion was made by Kelly, seconded by Ranieri to close the good and welfare portion of the meeting. The motion carried and Mayor Kappatos declared that portion of the meeting closed.

There being no further business to come before Mayor and Council at this time a motion was made by Farrell and seconded by Ranieri to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried and Mayor Kappatos declared the meeting adjourned at 8:33 PM.
